*The Canoe Race is one of the events in the annual Mora Classic Series and must be completed to be eligible for the Mora Classic Medal. Other Classic events are the Mora Half Marathon & 5K August 18, 2018; Mora Bike Tour, September 15, 2018; and Vasaloppet USA cross country ski race, February 9, 2019.

INVITATION

Join us for the 38th running of the Snake River Canoe Race. The race starts at 9:30 a.m. the first Saturday in May at the Hinckley Road Bridge on County Road 3 East.

ENTRY FEE

\$30.00 per canoe, Pro-Boat Racing Class & Open Racing Classes
\$30.00 per canoe, Citizen aluminum and Citizen non-aluminum
\$30.00 per kayak, two person (double) Kayak
\$20.00 per canoe/kayak, Solo Class and one person (single) Kayak

Use the attached entry form or print the form from the website at snakerivercanoeace.org. Entries postmarked **on or after** April 30 will incur an additional \$10 charge.

Race Day Registrations are \$20 more than what is on the Entry Fee Schedule. Race Day Registration will be available at the Kanabec History Center from 7 to 8 a.m. and then at the Start from 8:30 am to 9 am. Once registered, there will be a **\$10 fee for changing your class or partner. NO REFUNDS will be given.**

NOTE: This race is held only once per year on the first Saturday in May. "Make-ups" by persons unable to participate on race day are not allowed.

ABOUT THE RACE

The race starts at the Hinckley Road Bridge. Go 10 miles north from Mora on State Highway 65, then east on County Road 3, 2-1/2 miles to the Snake River.

Buses and canoe trailers will transport you and your canoe to the starting point. The first buses will leave at 7:00 a.m. and the last buses as well as the last canoe trailer leaves at 8:30 a.m.

If you drive to the starting area you must make your own arrangements to get your vehicle back to the finish area.

All canoes and kayaks will be started and timed by color-coded waves. The course is about 24 kilometers long. Mean gradient throughout the course is 5 feet per mile. Rapids are generally all Class I. Winning time is usually about two hours, and the average finishing time is about three hours.

CLASSES

Pro-Boat Class (Class PB), Open Racing Class (Class OR), Solo Class (Class Y), Kayak Class (Classes Z & ZZ) with sub-classes for men, women and mixed teams; and a Citizens Class with two divisions - aluminum and non-aluminum - which will be further broken down into 30 sub-classes (Class A through Class XX) according to ages and genders of team members. Canoe dimensional limitations for each class are shown on the map page.

AWARDS

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three overall finishers (per canoe or kayak, not person) of the event. 1st overall finisher-\$150, 2nd overall finisher-\$100, 3rd overall finisher-\$50. Trophies will no longer be awarded.

Medals will be given to first, second and third place finishers for men, women and mixed teams in each of five age groups for both Citizen Class divisions. Ages of team members, as of 12/31/17, are added together to determine age groups of 50 years and under, 51-70, 71-100, 101-130, and over 130.

For further information on individual class awards refer to the class descriptions.

Official timing ends at 2:00 p.m. due to the beginning of the award ceremony.

MORE INFORMATION

RENTALS: The club has nine aluminum canoes for rent. The price is \$50.00, which includes paddles and life vests. These canoes can be picked up at the start area just before the race and dropped off at the finish line, so you don't need to transport them. You can rent a canoe online at snakerivercanoeclub.org. In accordance with MN law, PFDs (personal floatation devices) are required for each paddler. Children under 10 must wear them at all times. If conditions warrant, we will highly recommend that people wear them.

You may call the individuals listed below for Snake River water level information or any other questions about the race that you may have. Water levels on the Snake River react quickly to rainfall and can rise or fall considerably within short time intervals. Check snakerivercanoeace.org for updates.

If you have a question about the size of your canoe and the class you should be entered in, measure your canoe and decide the class before you enter. If you are still in doubt, call or email one of the individuals below for assistance.

PRO-BOAT RACING CLASSES (Class PB)

- No age classes
- Medals to first, second and third place in class
PBA (male), PBB (female), PBC (mixed)
- Limitations: maximum length 18'-1/2" minimum width 27" at 3" waterline, must contain only 2 people

OPEN RACING CLASS (Class OR)

- No age classes
- Medals to first, second and third place in class
ORA (male), ORB (female) and ORC (mixed)
- Limitations: No restrictions on size. No pro-boats and no kayaks, must contain only 2 people.

CITIZENS CLASS - Aluminum Division

- Medals to first, second and third place finishers in Classes A thru LL

- Limitations: Each canoe must contain only 1 person and the paddle must have only one blade
- No age classes

KAYAK CLASS (Single Class Z) (Double Class ZZ)

- Medals to first, second and third place, male and female finishers in single kayaks (Class Z)
- Medals to first, second and third place overall finishers in double kayaks (Class ZZ)
- No age classes
- Only class with two-blade paddles
